## Beth Shalom Board of Directors Approves Sale of Wornall

I am pleased to report that on March 11th the CBS Board of Directors approved the sale of our Wornall campus to Van Trust, a real estate development company, for over \$2.5 million. The closing is scheduled to occur by the beginning of June 2013. Van Trust has not announced its plans for the property at this time. Our Buildings and Grounds Committee is busily planning for the sale and storage of the remaining items at Wornall.

The sale will allow us to pay off the remaining balance of the mortgage on the Lamar building and further pay

down our line of credit. Between reduction in borrowing costs and the elimination of the Wornall upkeep expenses we project to save over \$275,000 per year.

I am certain this news will bring mixed emotions. It signals the final step of our physical separation from our spiritual home at Wornall. Many cherished moments in our lives occurred within the walls of that Shul. It is my prayer that those memories not diminish.

The sale also culminates a several year effort by many members of our leadership to market Wornall to allow us to find sure financial footing.

Of course our work is not completed. A special committee of our Board is in the midst of studying our ideal facilities configuration. We will report on the Committee's progress as its work progresses.

juice
