## The Windows of Wornall

# From the Rabbi's Study



## Why Certified Kosher Cheese?

For decades, the Conservative Movement has ruled that according to Jewish Law, unprocessed/uncooked cheese and dairy products, as well as standard wines, did not require a Rabbinic Certification called a *"hekhsher"* or "Rabbinic Seal" to mark them as Kosher. Nevertheless, there

are good community reasons to require the higher standard of supervision.

Wines are presumed kosher from the start, unless a non-kosher ingredient has been deliberately placed in the vats or bottles. Yet the common convention is to require "certified" kosher wine at the very least for synagogue use and for ritual uses in the home. We have always required "Certified Kosher" wines at Beth Shalom, but not *"Certified Mevushal"* because we do not see formal idolatry as a likely threat at our functions.

Cheeses are a different issue. There is an honest difference of opinion in the *halakhah* among rabbinic authorities about a particular ingredient that may or may not be in an uncooked, fresh piece of cheese, from its original curdling process. The lenient voices allow all uncooked dairy products to be presumed kosher without certification, and

the more strict voices require full "kosher certification." It is the leniency that has been the policy of Beth Shalom for a long time.

Ours is a synagogue that seeks to be inclusive, warm and welcoming. A slight shift to the stricter standard in cheeses – certified kosher only – will open up our schools and congregation to a broader spectrum of the Jewish community. For example, we instantly become the only significant kosher preschool in town. You can be more inviting to your guests, and we can welcome all without hesitation. And that is what being a loving community is all about.

I invite your questions and concerns as we make this change July 1, of this year.

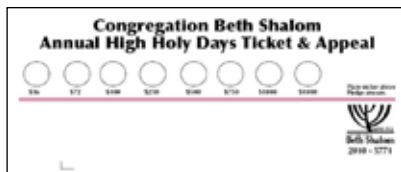

## High Holy Days Just Around the Corner CBS Ticket Policy 5771

Membership in good standing includes a maximum of two adult tickets and entry for children

age 24 or younger. Membership in good standing means meeting the established dues payment policy, which includes 30 percent of the current year's dues being paid, and being up-to-date on any payment due on a payment plan.

Current members who resign will have a five year waiting period before they can purchase High Holy Day tickets



as non-members. High Holy Day tickets for non-members will be available for \$200 per person. As a special incentive for non-members, a full credit for all tickets purchased can be applied to the first year's congregational dues if non-members join the congregation by November 1.

Special situations and exemptions for which tickets can be obtained free of charge include: out of town guests; full-time students with a

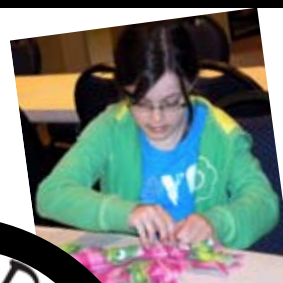
