New this year, there will be **NO CHARGE** for babysitting. However, reservations are required so we can provide proper staffing. You may bring a portable pack & play if you think you child will need to nap. If your child is not toilet trained, please bring diapers, wipes and a change of clothes. Please have your child's name on the diaper bag and **please label everything!**

Babysitting Guidelines

- 1. Only the age group designated will be allowed in the room.**
- 2. If you need to check on your child during service, please peek through the side window; do not come in the room. If there is no window, please get sitter's attention without disturbing the children. Extra visits and opening of the doors usually upsets the children after the sitter has them quieted down.**
- 3. No one other than a parent is allowed to remove a child from the Babysitting room under any circumstances.**
- 4. Meals cannot be served to individual children. The synagogue will provide water, cheese and crackers for the children.**
- 5. Only designated teenage helpers will be allowed in the rooms. A member of the staff will escort these teenagers to the proper rooms.**

These requests are made for the safety of your children and should be followed.
