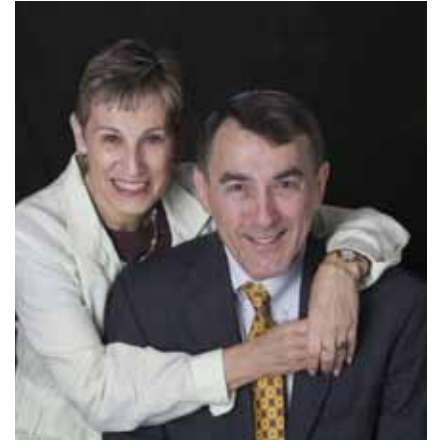

regular Torah reader which was particularly gratifying as it represents his continued determination to overcome challenges as well as religious progress. The many congregants who stepped forward to give D'verei Torah speak

volumes for the future vitality of Beth Shalom. Once again, as I stated last month, those who have been chosen to lead and have stepped forward, are to be thanked and commended; to the Board and officers of the synagogue and Sisterhood, the Foundation and all of the staff and the volunteers, todah rabbah and yashar kokhakhem.

Not to lose sight of my earlier messages, once July 1st comes David Glickman will be the senior rabbi of Beth Shalom. While, as I said, we will always be a part of Beth Shalom and you a part of us, Rabbi Glickman will assume the rabbinic place in your lives. Our move gives him space to do this. The Future Looks Good

This will be my last article for the Scroll. It is with sadness that I leave Kansas City and Congregation Beth Shalom. I hope I have given you a glimpse of what today's cantor might be: not just a singer, but a person knowledgeable in prayer, Torah, and music, a teacher, a person who goes beyond the p'shat of Torah and is not afraid to show passion for connecting to God. Beth Shalom deserves that much from its clergy. No longer just the role models for observing Halakhah, but the models for fairness, compassion, and spirituality – and for living in the modern world.

As in any field, the professional must know the tools of his trade. The cantor and the rabbi must know their subject matter, Torah and liturgy and nusach, but they must also be knowledgeable about communication, curriculum design, classroom management and finance. They must recognize the realities of a world of technology and be able to use it to the fullest, whether that's using computers, social networks, or audio engineering. This

Executively Speaking

Jewish Summer Camps-The Proof is in the Bug Juice



In the next several days many of our children will join an estimated 70,000 other Jewish students (approximately

10% of the Jewish youth population) at Jewish overnight camps across the country. Over the years many believed that attendance at Jewish summer camps created long-lasting positive effects on its alumni--but now we have the data to prove it.

Last year the Foundation for Jewish Camping released the results of a survey conducted by sociologist Steven M. Cohen--the most comprehensive to date-- on the positive impact of Jewish summer camps. The study

compared Jewish camp alumni with Jews of similar family, educational, financial and denominational backgrounds and experiences who did not attend camp.

Jewish camp alumni demonstrate higher levels of Jewish engagement in their adult years in a number of categories. For instance: strong emotional attachment to Israel (camp alumni 55% higher than the rest), attendance at synagogue services at least once a month (45% greater), regularly lighting Shabbat candles (37% greater), more likely to contribute to Jewish Federations (30%) more likely to join a shul (26%) and less likely to intermarry (10%).

For parents who are interested in sending their children to camp next summer, but struggle to find the financial means to do so, please be

aware that scholarship funds are available. Beth Shalom and the Jewish Community Foundation have funds available to help make camp a reality for your family.

For our students who will soon be off to Ramah, Herzl, Sabra and other Jewish camps this summer, please come to shul on Shabbat morning, June 9th, to be honored with a group Aliyah and your community's blessing for a wonderful summer.

We wish all of our campers a meaningful experience and ask that you bring back a taste of Camp Ruach to share with your shul.

POPPY SEED MANDELNBROT

1 cup plus 2 tablespoons sugar
Grated zest of 1 lemon or orange
1 cup oil
4 eggs
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1/3 cup poppy seeds
4 cups all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon baking powder
1 1/2 teaspoons ground cinnamon—divided



- Preheat oven to 325 degrees
- Grease baking sheet
- Blend 1 cup sugar with lemon or orange zest.
- Beat oil with sugar until combined
- Add eggs, vanilla and poppy seeds and blend thoroughly
- Combine flour, salt, baking powder and 1 teaspoon cinnamon and beat into egg mix until smooth
- Divide dough into 4 equal parts
- Shape each piece into oval loafs about 1 1/2-2 inches wide and place 2 inches apart on baking sheet
- Combine remaining 2 tablespoons sugar and 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon and sprinkle on top of loaves
- Bake 35-45 minutes until golden
- Remove from oven
- Transfer to board and cut into 1/2 inch thick slices
- Place cut side down on baking sheet and return to oven
- Turn off oven and leave for 10 minutes-until crisp
