## Creating our Kehillah Inspires Incoming President Dr. Norman Kahn, Jr.

When asked to share his vision as President of his CBS, Dr. Norman Kahn, Jr. revealed hopes to join with fellow congregants to create "a Kehillah, a sacred community, one we choose to belong to, contribute to, participate in. We will create our community through prayer and spirituality, congregational learning and engagement in community."

Dr. Kahn and his new officers and board will be installed, after being formally elected, at the congregational meeting and brunch, Sunday, June 22 at 10:00 am in Goldsmith Hall.

A native Kansas Citian, Dr. Kahn became a Bar Mitzvah at CBS. He and his wife, Diana Winyard, MD, are the parents of three sons and a daughter. He has served on the CBS board since 2008 and has also served as Vice President for Ritual and Executive Vice President.

Along with Alan Edelman, Dr. Kahn was co-chair of the Rabbinic Search Committee that chose Rabbi David Glickman. He has also served as Scoutmaster of Troop 61, held leadership positions in Kansas City Scouting and is a member of the National Jewish Committee on Scouting. Professionally, Dr. Kahn is Executive Vice President and Chief Executive Officer of the Council of Medical Specialty Societies, headquartered in Chicago. He is a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania, received his medical degree from the University of Kansas and completed his residency in family medicine at San Francisco General Hospital.

After practicing medicine in California, Dr. Kahn returned to Kansas City to work as Executive Director of the American Academy of Family Practice, and serves as a professor of Family Medicine at both UMKC and the University of Kansas Medical Center. He is Board Certified in Family Medicine and Geriatrics.

# From the Rabbi's Study

## Explore a New Synagogue: Congregation Beth Shalom

Vacations are important ways to recharge your batteries, and explore parts of the world where you've never been. I always recommend to congregants to try doing something Jewish in a new place on summer vacation.

Whether you are at camp, on vacation someplace or traveling from one destination to another – it is exciting to have the experience of trying something Jewish in a new place. By going to Friday night or Saturday morning services, attending a JCC program, or eating at a kosher restaurant in a new city, you can recharge your spiritual batteries and connect with another Jewish community.

However, you don't need to go away on vacation to recharge your spiritual batteries and explore new communities. Just as more and more people are trying "stay-cations", where you get a hotel room in your own town, and "visit" Kansas City as a tourist, you can have a Jewish "stay-cation" as well.

Just like Kansas City may have neighborhoods, shops and bistros you've never had a chance to explore, your own synagogue also has undis-

covered corners waiting for you to connect with them.

When you come to Shabbat morning services, do you usually come to our service in Goldsmith Hall? If so, how about checking out our Library Minyan held in Rooms 108 and 109. This community has had a member-led service for over twenty years, with congregants doing all the Torah reading, leading the service and doing the talk on the Torah portion. Do you usually go to Library Minyan? Has it been a while since you've come to Shabbat morning services in Goldsmith Hall without a special reason to go? Come feel the warmth that is being built in your own shul. We are blessed with two regular services on Shabbat morning, and I encourage newcomers and regulars alike to try both this summer.

Have you ever served food with Lechem? Have you ever experienced the energy of one of our Tot Shabbat mornings? (We have plenty of parents, grandparents, aunts and uncles who come – even without preschoolers).

What about the serenity and warmth of our daily minyan at Village Shalom? There is great comfort in knowing that your presence helped allow another to say Kaddish. What about Sisterhood or Men's Club – have you checked out these mini-communities? Gone shopping lately at our Sisterhood gift shop?

This summer, and into the fall – plan a Jewish "stay-cation" right here at Congregation Beth Shalom. If you need some "travel guidance" for your visit to CBS, please give me or Hazzan Ben-Yehuda a call or send us an email, and we will try to help you find the hidden gems of your own community.

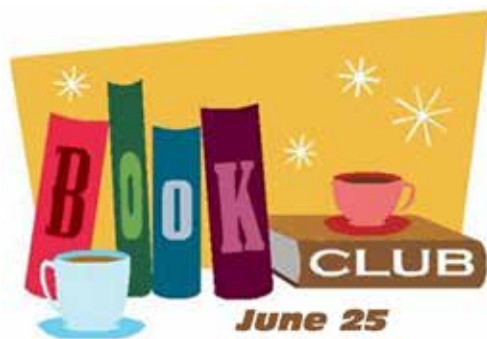

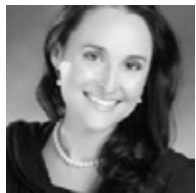
### Armchair Reserved Seating

## Cooking With Cathy

### Ingredients

- 4 tilapia fillets, about 2½ pounds
- ½ teaspoon sea salt
- 2 tablespoons fresh dill, minced, divided
- 4 to 6 sun-dried tomatoes, chopped
- ¾ cup kosher parmesan cheese
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- ¼ cup light mayonnaise

### Instructions

1. Preheat oven to 450° F.
2. Lightly grease a 9 x 13-inch pan with non-stick cooking spray.
3. Rinse fish, pat dry and place in prepared pan.
4. Sprinkle with salt and 1 tablespoon of dill.
5. Bake, uncovered, at 450° for 10 minutes.
6. In a bowl, mix sun-dried tomatoes, cheese, remaining dill, olive oil, lemon juice and mayonnaise.
7. Remove fillets from oven and turn oven to broil; spread sun-dried tomato mixture over fish.
8. Return to oven and broil for another 4 to 5 minutes, until cheese topping is slightly browned.
