It is an ancient and widespread custom for the firstborn to fast on the day before Passover commemorating the miracle which spared them from the plague that struck down the Egyptian firstborn.

This fast is treated leniently. Thus, if there is a festive meal that is connected with a mitzvah (for example the completion of a tractate of the Talmud), the firstborn participates in the meal rather than fasting.

With this in mind—all Beth Shalom firstborn are invited to join us
for services and a siyyum (celebration) as we complete
a tractate of Talmud.
